1. Graduation Credit Requirements: The minimum number of credits required for graduation is 30, including 16 credits of required courses [6 credits of College Required Courses and 10 credits of Departmental Required Courses] and 14 credits of elective courses. Students may take up to 6 credits, inclusive, from courses offered by other universities, graduate institutes, or program groups. Courses taken at other universities shall be governed by the University's Regulations for Intercollegiate Course Enrollment for Graduate Students.

2. Semester Credit: Students may take a maximum of 16 credits per semester and must enroll in at least one course each semester.

3. Thesis Oral Examination Requirement: Graduate students, including students in an extended period of study, who plan to graduate in the second semester of the academic year must publicly present their research at a relevant academic association or conference with an established review mechanism and must also present at the College Academic Research Presentation before applying for the oral examination of their thesis.

4.Distribution of Departmental Elective Credits: Students must complete a total of 14 credits of Departmental Elective Courses, distributed as follows:
Year 1: 3 credits in Semester 1 and 3 credits in Semester 2;
Year 2: 5 credits in Semester 1 and 3 credits in Semester 2.
